**Elings Park Tennis Courts**  
**Operational Rules and Regulations**

1. All players must display membership card or day pass on the court they wish to play at the designated areas. All players on the court must have a day permit or be a Member.
2. Singles - one hour court (60 minutes) reservation.  
Doubles - one and one half hour (90 minutes) reservation.  
Court time is subject to availability. Extended play allowed if there is no waiting list.  
Members can reserve next court user time by clipping under waiting their membership card or day pass at the court assigned areas.
3. Once your court time is up you must re-sign court for use if there are no members on the waiting list. This will provide anyone waiting for a court the opportunity to play.  
Court availability is subject to change.
4. Please be courteous to all players and wait until the point game is over and their time is up before taking your court.
5. No solicitations of tennis services or food services allowed on Elings Park Tennis Courts premises without written administrative approval.
6. Elings Park reserves the right to schedule tournaments and special events throughout the year and will provide advance notice.
7. No teaching can take place at the courts unless approved in writing by Elings Park Executive Director.
8. All people should follow EP Code of Ethics.

**Elings Park Code of Ethics**

**It is considered unbecoming conduct if any Member or non-Member while on the property of the EP Tennis Courts, engages in (A) abusive display of temper, (B) loud, abusive, or threatening language, (C) profanity, (D) obscene language or gestures, (E) racquet throwing, (F) behavior that could jeopardize the safety of persons or cause damage to property.**

Any of the above maybe considered as grounds for ejection from the EPTC property and/or cancellations of EPTC membership.
